Project Description:

This parking study investigated a variety of alternatives to accommodate existing and future parking demand. Several off-campus locations were investigated to provide a shuttle (Park & Ride) service to/from the downtown area. Other recommendations included the development of surface lots on adjacent parcels and the construction of a new parking garage to accommodate the future demand. The approach to this Study was to meet with each UHA entity to determine specific parking issues, existing constraints, and future demand. There were several committee meetings to share these findings of the Study and a Final Report was prepared.
